Notice of adoption of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal actions were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Beachwood.

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF BEACHWOOD, OHIO AND THE ADJOINING MUNICIPALITY OF ORANGE VILLAGE, OHIO PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 709.37 AND THE CITY'S CHARTER AND ORDINANCES AND ZONING THE NEW TERRITORY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.37, two adjoining municipal corporations may, by ordinance of their respective legislative authorities, agree to adjust their municipal boundaries, provided such adjustment does not involve the transfer of land inhabited by more than five voters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Beachwood and Orange Village desire to adjust the boundaries of their adjoining municipalities in an area along Chagrin Boulevard and Orange Place in order to allow certain property to be governed by the laws of only one municipality; to allow for the effective enforcement of both municipal codes; to conform the municipal boundaries to the existing property lines/uses; and to avoid any confusion regarding the provision of municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the territory involved includes businesses, parking spaces and green space; and

WHEREAS, the proposed adjustment will not affect any voters in either municipality; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to zone the new territory that will become part of the City of Beachwood as U-9, which is consistent with the existing zoning of the adjoining and adjacent properties in the City of Beachwood; and

WHEREAS, the City of Beachwood and Orange Village believe it is in the best interest of their respective communities to adjust the municipal boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Based upon the recommendation of the City Planner, the municipal boundaries of the City of Beachwood and Orange Village shall be adjusted pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.37 and as depicted in the diagram attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A". The City administration may take any further action as may be required by law to enact this boundary adjustment provided for in this Ordinance.

Section 2: The new territory to be included within the City's boundary, pursuant to this Ordinance, shall be zoned U-9 and subject to all laws generally applicable to properties within the City. The City Engineer shall cause the official zoning map of the City to be amended in accordance with this Ordinance.

<u>Section 3</u>: In the event that any property impacted by this boundary line adjustment is redeveloped and is projected to produce new income tax revenue, Orange and Beachwood commit to meet and enter into negotiations regarding an appropriate revenue sharing agreement.

Section 4: The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Orange Village Clerk and to the Cuyahoga County Clerk of Council and Executive.

Section 5: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committee relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.





AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2018-46, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO WILLO TRANSPORTATION; AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN URGENT MEASURE

WHEREAS, the Community Services Director recommended Willo Transportation for bus services for the 2018 Senior Trips for the City of Beachwood; and

WHEREAS, Council authorized the Mayor to issue a purchase order to Willo Transportation on February 20, 2018 per Ordinance No. 2018-46 in an amount not to exceed Sixteen Thousand Dollars and No/Cents (\$16,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Community Services Director has requested an amendment to the not to exceed amount set forth in Ordinance No. 2018-46.

Section 1: Based upon the recommendation of the Community Services Director as outlined in her request to the Mayor dated November 2, 2018, the Mayor is hereby authorized to increase the amount of the purchase order to Willo Transportation an additional Four Thousand Dollars and No/Cents for a total amount not to exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars and No/Cents (\$20,000.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal actions were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an urgent measure which is immediately necessary for the public peace, health or safety or the efficient operation of the City; and for the further reason that it is necessary to have these services readily available; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR THE 2019 CUYAHOGA COUNTY SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT PROGRAM, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT ANY GRANT FUNDS, EXECUTE ALL AGREEMENTS NECESSARY TO RECEIVE ANY AWARDED FUNDS; AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN URGENT MEASURE

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County is soliciting applications for the 2019 Cuyahoga County Supplemental Grant Program, a program that provides grant funding on a competitive basis for a variety of projects to help protect and strengthen cities, encourage regional collaboration and improve the quality of life for County residents; and
